## WHY MANY SDA'S WILL NOT RECEIVE THE LATTER RAIN

Are we hoping to see the whole church revived? <u>That time will never come</u>. There are persons in the church who are not converted, and who will not unite in earnest, prevailing prayer. <u>We must enter upon the work</u> <u>individually</u>. We must pray more, and talk less. Iniquity abounds, and the people must be taught not to be satisfied with a form of godliness without the spirit and power. If we are intent upon searching our own hearts, putting away our sins, and correcting our evil tendencies, our souls will not be lifted up unto vanity; we shall be distrustful of ourselves, having an abiding sense that our sufficiency is of God.

<u>We have far more to fear from within than from without</u>. The hindrances to strength and success are far greater from the church itself than from the world. 1 SM 122

In the manifestation of that power which **lightens the earth with the glory of God**, they will see only something which in **their blindness they think dangerous**, something which will arouse their fears, and they will **brace themselves to resist it**. **Because the Lord does not work according to their ideas and expectations, they will oppose the work**. "Why," they say, "should not we know the Spirit of God, when we have been in the work so many years?"—Because they did not respond to the warnings, the entreaties of the messages of God, but persistently said, "I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing." Talent, long experience, will not make men channels of light, unless they place **themselves** under the bright beams of the Sun of Righteousness, and are called, and chosen, and prepared by the endowment of the Holy Spirit. When men who handle sacred things will humble **themselves** under the mighty hand of God, the Lord will lift them up. He will make them men of discernment—men rich in the grace of his Spirit. Their strong, selfish traits of character, their stubbornness, will be seen in the light shining from the Light of the world. "I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent." If you seek the Lord with all your heart, he will be found of you.
